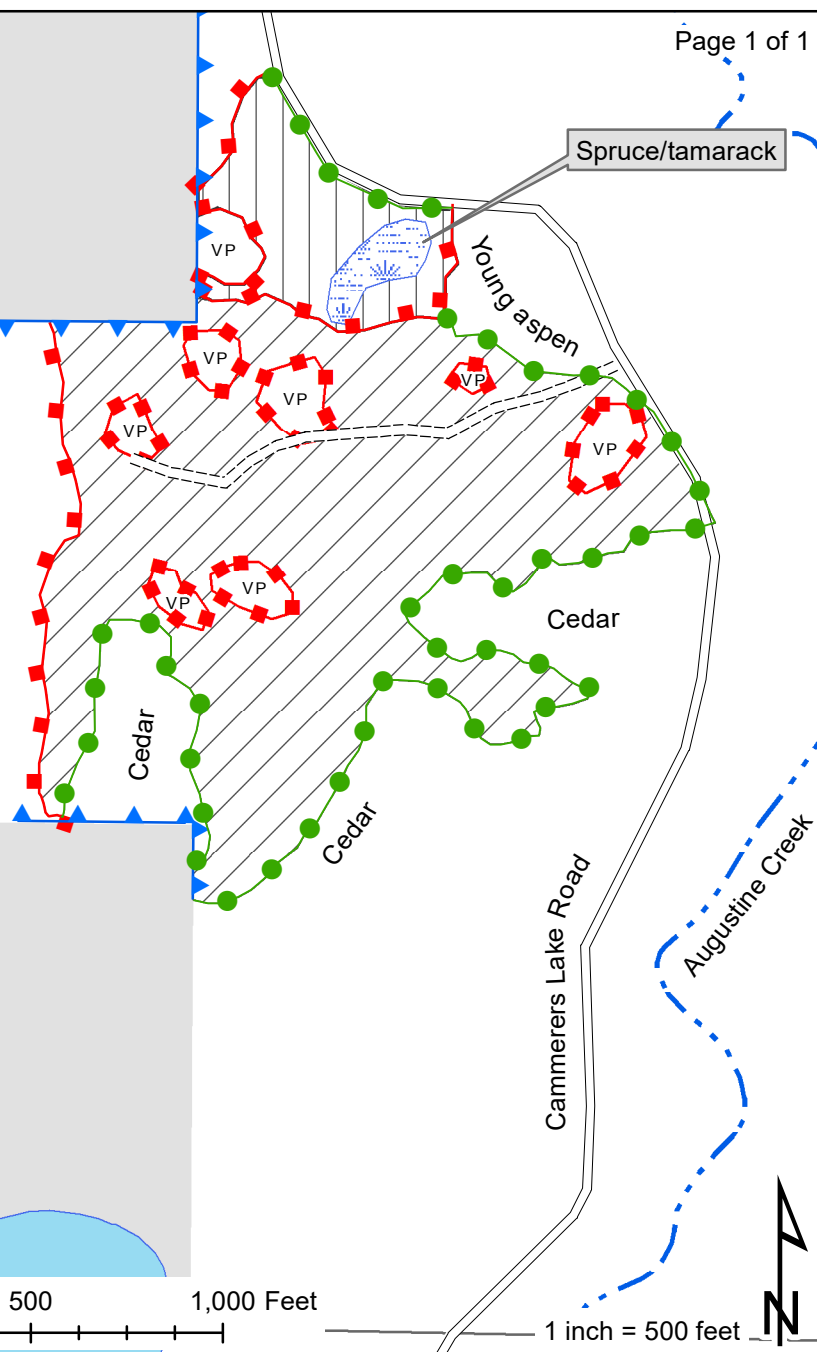
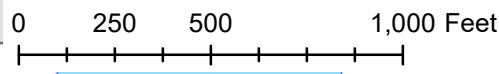

CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS:

- Harvesting will be limited to dry summer or frozen winter ground conditions between August 15th & March 15th.
- In both harvest areas reserve all: oak, pine, cedar, hemlock, green-painted trees, and any snags not posing a safety hazard, except snags within 50 feet of Cammerers Lake Rd.
- In both harvest areas do not cut small diameter, quality pole timber that contains 1-3 pulp sticks.
- In the spruce overstory removal area, cut all merchantable non-reserve trees containing at least one 100-inch pulp stick.
- In the leave tree mark harvest area, cut all merchantable non-reserve trees containing at least one 100-inch pulp stick.

CUTTING RESTRICTIONS:

- Excessive rutting or excessive damage to residual trees shall result in the suspension of logging operations.
- Avoid equipment operation in areas of advanced regeneration where there is no harvestable or merchantable timber.
- The sale must be cut progressively.
- No new woods roads shall be constructed without prior approval by the county forester.
- Do not operate equipment or fell timber into red-lined vernal pools.
- Care must be taken to preserve any survey monuments.
- Berm roads when the sale is not active, and upon completion of logging operations.
