### **Sub-committee reports:**

#### **Jail Population Review:**

46 in the jail, 8 females boarded out, 13 on EMP,

#### **TAD report:**

Four people on TAD, two are partnered with Drug Court

#### **Probation/Parole**

There are four new agents in agent basic training. Unit 601 has 513 supervised cases; 25 are in jail on holds; 17 are in revocation status

#### **Adult Drug court report:**

21 active cases; 5 are being assessed to participate; ADC had their annual retreat last month and the minutes from that retreat will be discussed with the team members.

#### **Longrun report:**

Working with Community Corrections Employment program to establish a job site.

## **Truancy:**

Truancy numbers are down; overall truancy scores are down in the state report card and with Dept. of Public Instruction.

## **Children of Incarcerated Parents:**

Child exchange protocol and locations are being finalized. Considering applying for a grant to establish a Child Advocacy Center.

## **CCR (Coordinated Community Response)**

Provided copies of Justice by the Bay newsletter.

On November 10th DOJ is doing a specialty training on strangulation

As noted above in Children of Incarcerated Parents there is work going on to provide safe child exchange sites and also a child advocacy center.

## **Northlakes Hope Program – SASE**

12 active, 4 out, 20 released to date in the 4 months of the program; two have gone back into custody.

## **New Business:**

### **Round Robin**

District Attorney – TADPRO – Ashland counties bail jumping rates are one of the highest in the county.

2016 – 242 Felony cases – 98 allegations of bail jumping; 39 of these are new criminal charges, 3 for failure to appear, and 8 that violated absolute sobriety.

2015 – 51 bail jumping's

Amanda Popovich – discussed ACES (adverse childhood experiences) and hopes to get training for their staff in dealing with problems related to ACES; the school purchased the film “Paper Tigers” , they have limited licensure for viewings.

Judge Eaton – State vs Loomis COMPAS score can be included in a PSI
