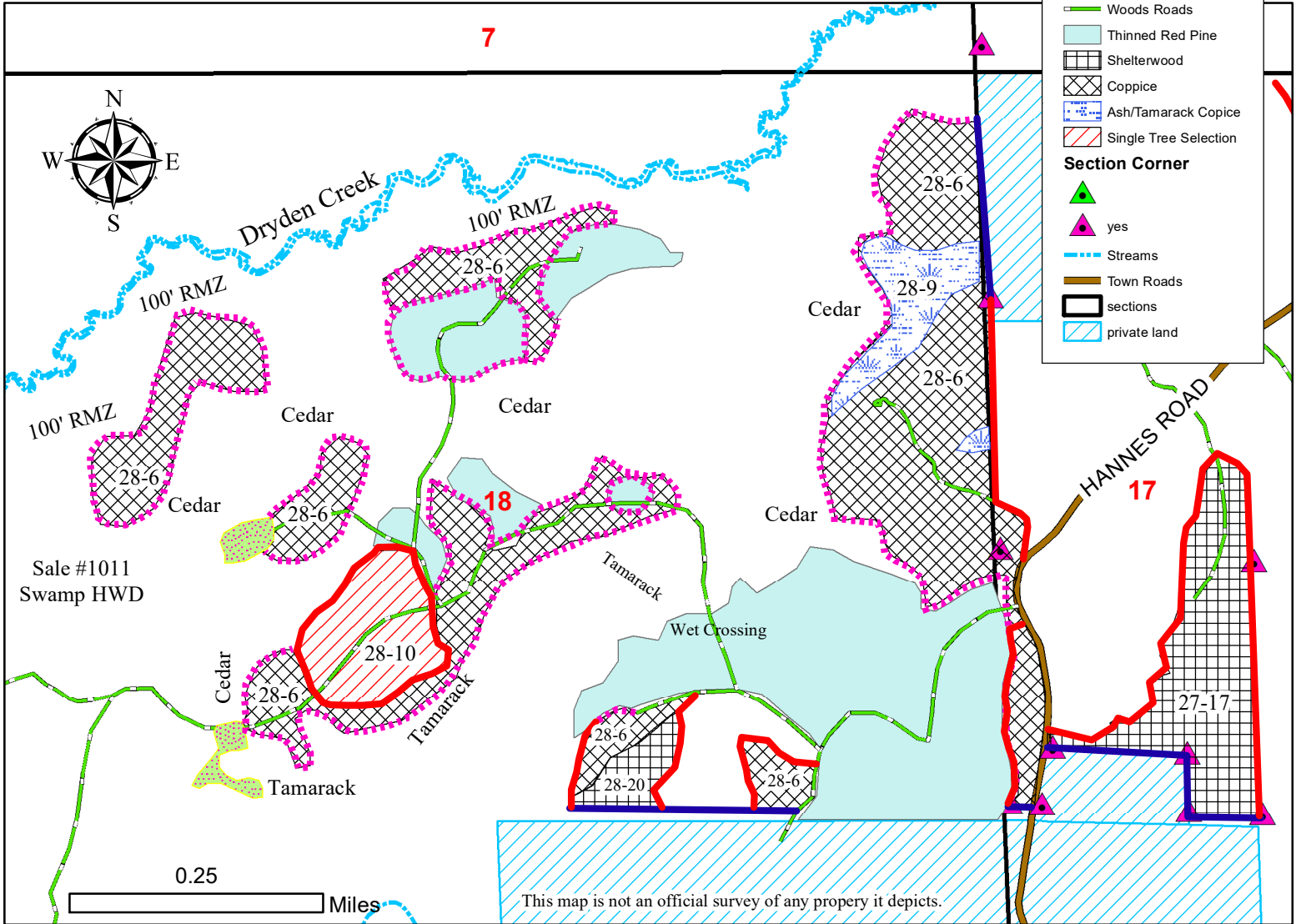

Cutting Restrictions:

- Dry or frozen ground conditions only
- Excessive rutting or excessive damage to residual trees shall result in the suspension of logging.
- The sale must be cut progressively.
- No new woods roads shall be constructed without prior approval of the county forester.
- Care must be taken to preserve survey monuments.
- Care must be taken to not excessively damage existing saplings.

Tamarack Pulp	10 cords	\$5.00/ Cord
Balsam Fir Pulp	250 cords	\$5.00/ Cord
Hard Maple Logs	4 MBF	\$120.00/ MBF
Mxd Logs	7 MBF	\$100.00/ MBF

Cutting Specifications:

- Single Tree Selection: (10 Acres) Cut all orange marked trees within the sale boundary. Cut all balsam, ash and iron wood.
- Coppice: (65 Acre) Cut all trees 2" and larger except reserve trees. **Reserve trees are oak, yellow birch, white birch, cedar, hemlock and any trees marked with green paint. Leave 2-3 spruce or yellow birch per acre. There are oak saplings throughout the aspen stand DO NOT CUT.**
- Leave 100' balsam buffer along Dryden Creek on north end of sale.
- Shelter wood: (21 acres) Cut all trees 2" and larger except reserve trees. **Reserve trees are cedar, hemlock, oak and trees marked with green paint.**
- Sale boundary includes red paint line, blue paint line, natural boundary, woods road and town road.
