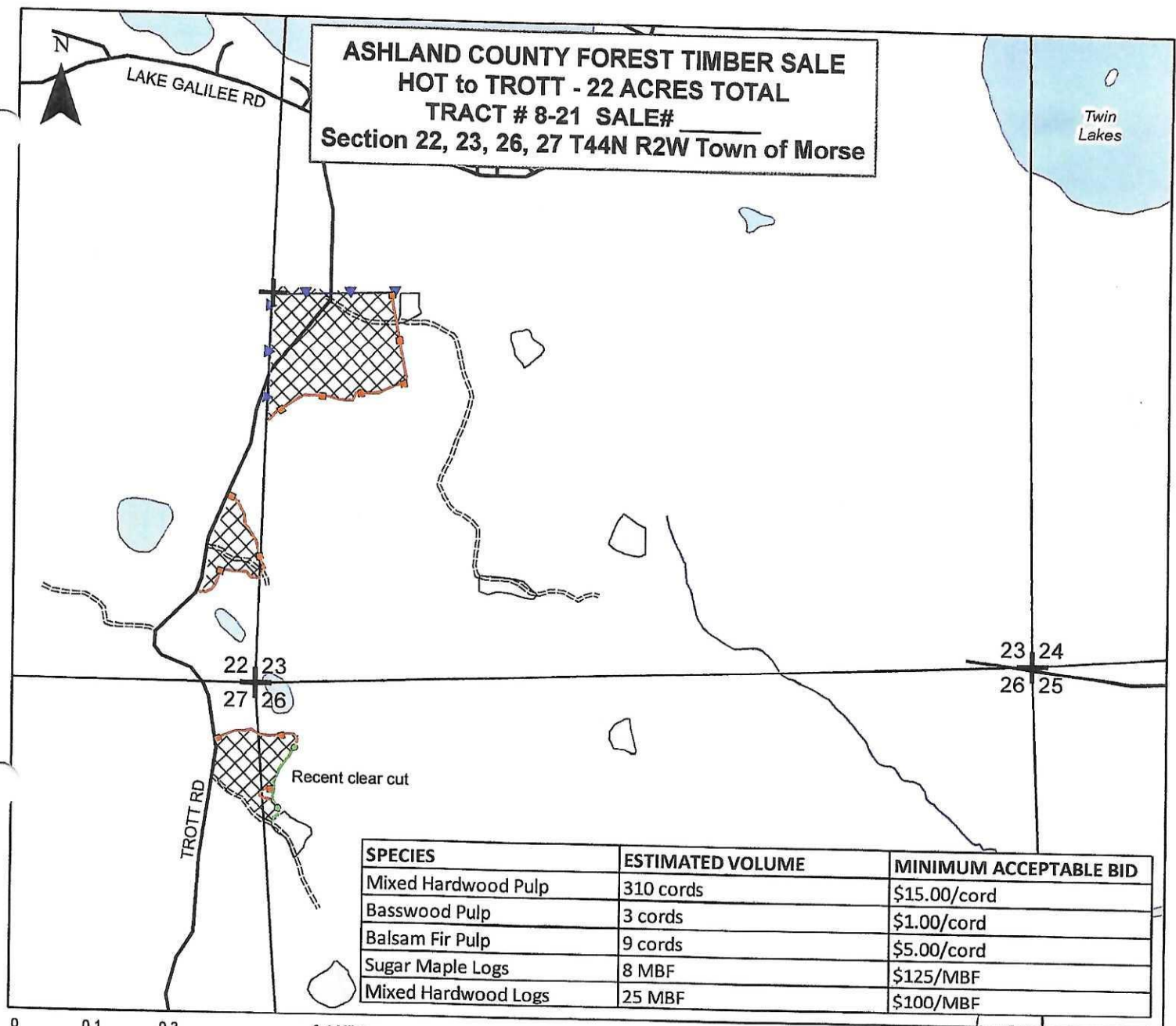
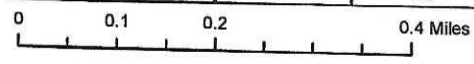

CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS:



Shelterwood Area (22 acres)(C1-S2): Harvest all trees 1" and larger except designated reserve trees and trees marked with GREEN PAINT.

- Designated reserve trees are all Hemlock, Cedar, White Pine, Spruce and Oak*.
**Special care should be taken to protect oak trees and saplings.*
- Utilize all felled trees to a 4" minimum top diameter for pulpwood and a 10" minimum top diameter for saw logs.

CUTTING RESTRICTIONS:

- Excessive rutting or excessive damage to residual trees shall result in the suspension of logging operations.
- The sale must be cut progressively
- Leave a 15 foot buffer strip around all vernal pools.
- No new woods roads shall be constructed without prior approval by the county forester
- Care must be taken to preserve any survey monuments.
- Berm woods roads when the sale is not active, and upon completion of logging operations.
- Retain suitable den trees and all snags that do not pose a safety hazard.
- Operations shall occur on dry summer or frozen winter frozen ground only.
