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Registration for Ashland County Well Testing

You are invited to learn more about your groundwater by participating in a **drinking water testing program** sponsored by the Ashland County Land and Water Conservation Department (LWCD).

A priority of the Ashland County LWCD is to protect drinking water and groundwater through monitoring, education, healthy land practices, and proper well abandonment. This program is not mandatory or regulatory but simply an educational opportunity to learn about your groundwater and receive recommendations to ensure clean, healthy drinking water.

In conjunction with the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point Water and Environmental Analysis Lab, the Ashland County Land and Water Conservation Department is excited to announce the opportunity for Ashland County property owners this spring. The Lab is state-certified to perform these tests. We are conducting two test packages per well sampled: The **Homeowner's Package** tests for nitrate, coliform bacteria, pH, alkalinity, hardness, conductivity, corrosivity, and chloride; and the **Metals Package** tests for arsenic, calcium, copper, iron, lead, magnesium, manganese, potassium, sodium, sulfate, and zinc.

DON'T SEND ANY MONEY. We need your registration before **March 14th, 2025** to reserve your test kit, and will collect payment at the time of bottle pickup. Ashland County will be funding 40 test kits at a **reduced cost of \$65.50** (this includes both the Homeowners and Metals packages) and will start a waiting list for next year if interest exceeds funding capabilities.

To participate, you must be able to commit to the following:

- ❖ Pick up and pay for your sample bottles at the Ashland LWCD office **8 AM- 4 PM from March 17th-21st, 2025.**
- ❖ Collect and return your sample on **Monday March 24th, 2025 between 8AM- 2pm** at the **Land and Water Department office** following the directions provided with your sample bottles.
